***Emergency Admissions to Ohio Medicaid Certified Nursing

As most of us are aware, emergency situations often come up out of nowhere. Can they be prevented or planned for to lessen the shock once they occur? In certain circumstances they can if you have the right plan of action.

Emergency NF admissions from the community or a hospital emergency room will be explored. In doing so, we will explain what needs to be done for different payment options and what happens when further review for a mental illness, mental retardation/developmental disorders is required. In these circumstances, time is of the essence and we would like to help you accomplish the ultimate goal of helping people get in the safest possible environment in the quickest fashion.

This course would be especially helpful to those assisting frail clients in the community and in hospital emergency rooms.

Specifically, we will address;

- How to best prepare for an emergency
- The best course of action when an emergency occurs
- How the Ohio PASRR & LOC (Level of Care) is addressed
- What forms will need to be completed
- How to get your emergency request expedited
- Where to forward the required paperwork for the emergency
- Who to talk to for questions related to the emergency
- How to locate the closest mental health agency
- How to locate the closest hospital with a mental health unit

The way we will address the above mentioned issues is through specific scenarios, links to videos that we have produced and links to agencies and forms.

The information (The topics listed above) will be provided to participants with a short true/false post test and an evaluation. Once the completed post test and evaluation are received, the participant will receive a CEU certificate.
